Although with a Great Western flavour, it also includes such classics as the Caledonian Railway No.123, LBSCR "Bessborough" and LMS "Princess Elizabeth", as well as the Talylyn Railway's diminutive "Sir Hayden". Each locomotive is accompanied by historical notes and an easy-to-understand and not-too-technical description. Added to this is the author's own story of his boyhood spent watching steam locomotives from the lineside which led to his employment on the GWR - all backed up with a host of contemporary photographs of locomotives.
